Part-time Visiting Faculty Position in Environmental Studies

The College of the Holy Cross invites applications for a visiting part-time faculty position to teach one course, **ENVS 247 Introduction to Geographic Information Systems**, during the Spring 2018 semester to begin in January 2018. This course is an essential component of the multidisciplinary Environmental Studies (ENVS) major and minor curriculum. This course has an expected enrollment of ~20 students and is scheduled to meet **MW 6:30-7:45 pm** in a computer lab furnished with PCs installed with ArcGIS and Google Earth. We also have a set of Garmin handheld GPS units which can be used for assignments. The successful candidate will be provided with office space and is expected to hold weekly office hours. The single-course salary for a visiting lecturer is \$6,425.

Please submit a letter of application, current *curriculum vitae*, a statement on teaching experience and philosophy including a sample syllabus that reasonably follows the course description, transcripts (Ph.D. preferred), and two confidential letters of recommendation. Candidates must demonstrate commitment to, and excellence in, undergraduate teaching as informed by current practice and scholarship in the field. In your letter of application, please address the ways you might contribute to the College's core commitment to diversity and inclusion as a Jesuit, undergraduate liberal arts college (see <http://www.holycross.edu/mission>).
